Jaap van Milgen obtained an MSc degree from Wageningen University and a PhD degree from the University of Illinois in animal science.

In 1992, he joined INRA and obtained a permanent position on the nutritional modeling of growth in pigs.

He also developed a research program of energy and amino acid nutrition. Since 2012, he has been head of the INRA-Agrocampus Pegase research unit. Pegase's mission is to "identify the biological basis and conceive levers by which animal production will contribute efficiently and responsibly to a sustainable development".

He is coordinator of the Feed-a-Gene project (funded by the European Horizon 2020 program), which aims to adapt the feed, the animal and the feeding techniques to improve the efficiency and sustainability of monogastric livestock production systems.
